

The latest review of restrictions was announced on 14/05/2021. The next review is on the 4th June.

On Monday 17th May: **Wales is in alert level 2.**

- Indoor hospitality can reopen. Up to 6 people from 6 households (under 11's not included) per table.
- All holiday accommodation can fully reopen.
- Entertainment venues can reopen including cinemas, bowling alleys, indoor play centres and areas, casinos, amusement arcades and theatres.
- Cinemas, theatres, concert halls and sport grounds can sell food and drinks providing it can be consumed in a seated area.
- Indoor visitor attractions including museums and galleries can reopen.
- Up to 30 people can take part in organised indoor activities and up to 50 people can take part in outdoor activities. This includes weddings and wakes.

Depending on the public health situation the following restrictions could be eased on June 7th: **Wales will also move into Alert Level 1**

- Rule of 6 for indoor visits in private homes.
- Up to 30 people can meet outdoor with social distancing – for example food and drinks.
- Up to 3 households can form an extended household.
- Organised indoor activities for up to 50 people and 100 people for organised outdoor activities. Including weddings and wakes.
